Homework

- All homework assignments are to be completed and ready to check and/or turn in at the beginning of the class that they are due.
- Homework may only be done in **PENCIL** and must be formatted correctly. The format for

- Homework is practice/learning work and not all assignments will be graded but all will be corrected and discussed. Although your assignment might not be for a grade each time, it is expected to be done and please, please, please ask questions if you do not understand or need clarification.

- Your homework assignments should be done in your spiral, on the homework assignment sheet, or on Google Classroom. The location of your assignment and where it should be turned in will be clearly indicated to you.

Grades
