

Spiral Policy

1. Spirals are to be done in a neat, orderly fashion. **COMPLETE YOUR WORK IN YOUR SPIRALS WITH PENCIL.** We will start notes with a clear label with the topic we are talking about, followed by guided practice for the lesson, then ended with independent practice.
2. You are required to write down everything the teacher writes on the board. If it is important enough for the teacher to write it on the board, it is important enough for you to have in your spirals.
3. Spirals will be checked weekly. The spiral check will be written on the assignment board and placed online.
 - a. The spiral check consists of the following points:
 - i. 1 pt - Dates and titles on all days and lessons
 - ii. 1 pt - Independent practice shows effort
 - iii. 1 pt - Neatness/completion
4. Spirals are to be stored in Mr. Wolf's room and should only leave if you have asked permission to take your spiral home.
5. Your notes are your success. Take good notes and learn to be a great student!
